Whereas Matthew Blairis of the County of Southampton and parish of St. Mary's, doth on the 19th day of February in the year of our Lord 1834 make and give a deed of trust to Benjamin Griffin as Trustee in or as certain tract of lands containing seventy seven and three fourths acres and a sum or sums of money due the said Henry Senior and the said Matthew Blairis having failed to comply with the requirements of said deed and the said Benjamin Griffin as Trustee having been required by the terms of said Henry Senior's deed to sell should and in order to raise the said sum or sums of money therein mentioned has duly advertised the same to be sold to the highest bidder for cash on the 23rd day of October 1834. Now this Indenture made this day of October in the year of our Lord 1834 One thousand Eight hundred and thirty three Benjamin Griffin selling as Trustee of the one part and Henry Blairis of the other part do hereby certify that the said Benjamin Griffin as Trustee aforesaid doth sell and shall at public auction on the 23rd day of October 1834 the seventy seven and three fourths acres of land as described above for the consideration of the sum of One hundred and sixty one dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to have the said Benjamin Griffin as Trustee in hand paid by the said Henry Blairis the sum aforesaid before the closing and delivery of the presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Blairis bargained and sold at public auction and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Henry Blairis his heirs and assigns all and singular other the premises herebefore mentioned or intended to be sold and conveyed and parcel thereof with all the right of the said Benjamin Griffin as Trustee aforesaid unto the said Henry Blairis his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Griffin as Trustee aforesaid for himself his heirs the 77 3/4 acres of land more or less with all the tenancies herebefore mentioned unto the said Henry Blairis his heirs and assigns forever free from the claims of him the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs Executors administrators and assigns as Trustee as aforesaid. Shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof I the said Benjamin Griffin have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written.
