This Agreement entered into by Samuel Polkirkham and T. R. Gray in his own right and as agent of
 John Mughart Mltrephers that the said Polkirkham hath bought of the said Gray the

 conveyed by said Gray for the benefit of John Mughart to R. A. Mughart the conditions of
 said purchase be as follows the said John Mughart conveying to said Polkirkham, all that

 to pay the sum of Eight hundred dollars by three annual payments the first to be paid (one
 third of Eight hundred dollars) on the 20th of December 1834. with interest from the date
 the 2nd on the 20th of December 1835. with interest from the date and the third on the 20th
 of December 1836. with interest as aforesaid, the said Conveyance to be executed as soon as
 convenient during the present year and the said Polkirkham to be allowed the value of
 said property which has been pulled down by T. C. Jones. Mltrephers, whereof the parties have
 here set their hands and seals this 21st of November 1833.
