This Agreement entered into by Samuel Polkirkham and J. R. Gray in his own right and as agent of
John Maguhard Maitrepreneur that the said Polkirkham hath bought of the said Gray the
Polkirkham house and lot in the Town of Jerusalem which Thomas C Jones now occupies and in which was
conveyed by said Gray for the benefit of John Maguhard to R. A. Maguhard the conditions of
said purchase be as follows the said John Maguhard conveying to said Polkirkham all that
as is noted in him by the purchase from R. A. Maguhard and do order the said Polkirkham
to pay the sum of Eight hundred dollars by three annual payments the first to be paid one
third of Eight hundred dollars on the 25th of December 1834. with interest from the date
the 2nd on the 25th of December 1835. with interest from the date and the third on the 25th
of December 1836. with interest as aforesaid the said conveyance to be executed as soon as
convenient during the present year and the said Polkirkham to be allowed the value of
saying which has been pulled down by J. C. Jones. In Testimony whereof the parties have
