 This Indenture made this 18th day of November in the year 1833 Between Sampson Little and Eliza his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Alfred Hops of the County of Chesapeake and State of Virginia of the other part Witness that the said Sampson Little and Eliza his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Five thousand dollars (current money of Virginia) to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Alfred Hops his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate being the same whereon the said Little now resides Swamp and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a live oak on the west side of the aforesaid a swampy tract of land corner of Daniel Butler's land thence along said line West by 170 Three hundred and thirty poles to a pine corner tree of Daniel Butler's acreage thence South six leagues East two hundred poles to a red sapling a corner tree of Charles Simmons thence down a line of the late Capt. Dan. Butler's land to a corner tree for W.^m Hilde's and Jose Cobb's then thence a straight line to the lands to Eliza corner from thence a straight line to a dead pine standing in the lands in said Eliza's line thence down the Warren's course of said lands to a few cypress standing on edge of the main run of the aforesaid Swamp another corner of said Hilde's land thence up the aforesaid Swamp to the beginning containing 388¹/₂ acres more or less To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land with all and every the appurtenances thereunto belonging to him the said Alfred Hops his heirs and assigns forever and the said Sampson Little and Eliza his wife for themselves their heirs the said Land and premises with the appurtenances to the said Alfred Hops his heirs and assigns against them the said Sampson Little and Eliza his wife and their heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and shall these presents forever remain and defend In Testimony whereof the said Sampson Little and Eliza his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed seals this day and year first above written.
