This Indenture made and entered into this third day of October one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty three between Robert L. Lockhead of the County of Shenandoah and State of Virginia
 of the one part and David Harris of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witness
 in presence that he and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and fifty dollars to the
 said Lockhead on hand paid by the said Harris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 that the said Robert L. Lockhead has granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 doth grant bargain sell and confirm to the said David Harris his heirs and assigns
 forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being on the south side the above
 Oaks in the County and State aforesaid and bounded as follows on the north
 by the land of Francis Ridley and the said David Harris on the west by the
 land of Francis Ridley and William Judkins on the north by the land belong-
 ing to the Estate of Jacob Judkins and Spradley Williams and on the East by the
 land belonging to the Estate of Robert Fort it being the tract of land in which the
 said Lockhead now lives and containing seven hundred and forty acres be the same
 more or less with all the improvements privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging
 To have and to hold unto the said David Harris his heirs and assigns forever
 which land the said Robert L. Lockhead do warrant and forever defend the title to
 the said David Harris his heirs and assigns forever against the claims or claims of
 any and every person whomsoever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal the day and date first above written.
