To Jeremiah Cobb and Ann Cobb his wife of the one part and James Rockelle of the other all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that the said Jeremiah Cobb and Ann Cobb his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and Eighty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said James Rockelle at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Jeremiah Cobb and Ann his wife have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Rockelle his heirs Executors and administrators the following Tracts or parcels of land to wit: One tract containing one tract and forty two acres and Eighteen poles one tract containing five acres, one tract containing one hundred and twenty Eight acres Three rods and thirty five poles and one tract containing sixty one acres with all and singular the premises and appurtenances unto the said tracts or parcels of land belonging or in anywise appertaining they being the same or parcels of land conveyed by the said James Rockelle as administrator with the Will annexed of John Thomas dec^d to the said Jeremiah Cobb as will appear by his deed to the said Jeremiah Cobb bearing date this 15th day of April 1833. and of Record in the Clerk's Office of said County Court. To have and to hold the above described Tracts or parcels of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said James Rockelle his heirs and assigns forever. To and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Rockelle his heirs Executors administrators and assigns. And the said Jeremiah Cobb and Ann his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators the above described Tracts or parcels of land and premises with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto him the said James Rockelle his heirs Executors and administrators shall and lawfully warrant and defend by these presents against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons claiming by through or under them or either of them. and no further.
