Rochelle all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas that the said Jeromiah
and Ann Cobb his wife of and in Consideration of the sum of One Thousand and Eighty
to them in hand paid by the said James Rochelle at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said James
and Ann his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant sell
and sell alien and release and Convey unto the said James Rochelle his heirs Executors
Administrators the following Tracts or parcels of land to wit: One tract containing
and forty two acres and Eighteen poles one tract containing five acres, one tract contain-
ing one hundred and Thirty Eight acres three rods and thirty five poles and
containing Sixty one acres with all and singular the premises and appurtenances unto
said tract or parcels of land belonging or in any wise appertaining they being the same
or parcels of land Conveyed by the said James Rochelle as administrator with the Will in
of John Thomas dec'd to the said Jeromiah Cobb as will appear by his Will to date
bearing date this 15th day of April 1833 and of Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton
County Court. To have and to hold the above described Tracts or parcels of land and
with all and singular the premises and appurtenances therunto belonging unto
the said James Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever. To stand for the only payment
to him the said James Rochelle his heirs Executors administrators and assigns
And the said Jeromiah Cobb and Ann his wife for themselves their heirs Executors
Administrators the above described Tracts or parcels of land and premises with all and
singular the premises and appurtenances therunto belonging unto him the said James
Rochelle his heirs Executors and administrators shall and will warrant and defend
defend by these presents against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons
