This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of November 1833 between Nicholas M. Potts
Edward of the County of Southampton of the one part and Henry B. Vaughan of the same County
the other part. Whereas John T. Vaughan in order to secure the payment of a certain
sum of money due from him to the said Nicholas M. Potts by an Indenture bearing date on the
day of October 1833 and admitted to record on the same day did convey to the said
R. Edwards all his the said John T. Vaughan's interest in the lands wherof his said
John T. Vaughan late seized and possessed in the County of Southampton in the sum
of £100 and with power and authority to said Sudditor R. Edwards to sell the same for
the purpose of paying the debt and the expenses attending the execution of the said Indenture
the said John T. Vaughan should fail to pay the debt at the time stipulated in the
Indenture. And whereas the said John T. Vaughan having failed to pay the said
debt and the said Nicholas M. Potts having on enquiry thereof accounted
of the interest aforesaid to be made for the purpose aforesaid and the said Sudditor
Edwards in execution of the same after giving reasonable notice of the time and place of sale
did on the 18th day of November 1833 expose to sale at public auction to the highest bidder
for ready money the interest of the said John T. Vaughan in the lands wherof his
said seized and possessed in the County of Southampton at which the said Henry B.
became the purchaser of the said interest before mentioned at the price of £100, and
that being the highest bid made for the same and that sum he has paid to the
Sudditor R. Edwards on this Indenture. Whereas that the said Sudditor
Edwards for and in consideration of the premises and of the said £100 being paid
to him in hand paid back given granted bargained and sold and did by his
good grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and
all the interest which the aforesaid John T. Vaughan has in the lands of which
his father late seized and possessed in the County of Southampton. To have and to
the said interest unto the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns for
their only proper use and behoof forever. And the said Sudditor R. Edwards doth
hereby execute and administer hereby command to and unto the said Vaughan
and assigns that he will forever warrant and defend the said interest hereby and
said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns against the claim of the said
