This Indenture made this 21st day of May in the year of our Lord Eight hundred and thirty three Between Frances Lenore, Executrix of Henry Lenore (with the Well Claimed) of the County of Pichampton, and State of Virginia of the one part and Samuel Lenore of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Frances Lenore, Executrix of Henry Lenore do^c for and in Consideration of the sum of One thousand and five dollars and fifty cents to her in hand paid by the said James Lenore the receipt whereof the said Frances Lenore doth hereby acknowledge, and hereof fully satisfied and paid and of this same debt by these presents acquit the said James Lenore she the said Frances Lenore, Executrix of Henry Lenore do^c forth grant bargain and sold, aliened conveyed, confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said James Lenore one certain tract plantation or parcel of land which was left by the said Henry Lenore in his last will and Testament to be sold containing by estimation one hundred and seventy five acres more or less lying and being situated in the County of Pichampton and State of Virginia being the same tract of land which the said Henry Lenore bought of Albrighton Sperry before he the Office of this County well more fully appear with all the appurtenances thereto belonging given any way appertaining with the same and Reversions, Remainders and Remainders rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said bargain premises with the appurtenances unto the said James Lenore his heirs and assigns forever and the said Frances Lenore, Executrix of Henry Lenore do^c for herself her heirs Executors and Administrators the said bargain premises and every part and parcel thereof with all their appurtenances to have and to receive clear exempt and secure from all claims or other incumbrances whatso ever unto the said James Lenore his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons whatsoever does shall and well by these presents forewaived.
