the same debt by these presents acquit the said James Lenoir the said James
Lenoir. Executrix of Henry Lenoir late of which granted by agreement made & told, acknowledged
and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alienate off and
convey unto the said James Lenoir one certain tract plantation or part of land
which was left by the said Henry Lenoir in his last will and Testament to be sold
extinguishing by estimation one hundred and seventy five acres more or less lying and being situated
in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being the same tract of land which the said
Henry Lenoir brought of Albany town New York before to the Office of the Land court mercifully
appear with all the appurtenances thereto belonging given any way appertaining and its own
sum and premium, damages and remainderments rents issues and profits thereon and every
part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said bargain provided with the appurtenances
unto the said James Lenoir his heirs and assigns forever and the said Francis Lenoir Executrix
of Henry Lenoir deceased herself her heirs Executors and Administrators the said lands and premises
and every part and parcel thereof free and clear of all appurtenances what so ever clear or complaint
thereon from all claims or else in contraries what so ever unto the said James Lenoir his heirs
and assigns against all and every sum or summe whatever does shall and will be hereafter
