

This Indenture made this 21st day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
 hundred and thirty three between Frances Senor, Executrix of Henry Senor dec^d (which
 Senor was deceased) of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and
 Joseph Senor of the same County of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Frances
 Senor Executrix of Henry Senor dec^d for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred
 and thirty eight Cents to her in hand paid by the said Joseph Senor, the receipt
 of the said Frances Senor doth hereby acknowledge and herself fully satisfied and paid
 and of the same doth by these presents acquit the said Joseph Senor, the said
 Frances Senor Executrix of Henry Senor dec^d hath granted bargained and sold
 confirmed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien confirm
 confirm unto the said Joseph Senor one certain tract plantation or parcel of land (which
 was left by the said Henry Senor in his last Will and Testament to be sold) containing
 by estimation twenty two and half acres more or less lying and being situate in the County
 of Southampton and state of Virginia being the same tract of land which the said
 Senor bought of John Washington, referred thereto more fully appears, the said
 tract or in any case appertaining with the accursed and accursed, remainder and
 rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and
 to hold the said bargained premises, with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph
 Senor his heirs and assigns forever and the said F. Senor for herself her heirs
 and assigns the said bargained premises and every part and parcel thereof and
 their appurtenances whatsoever clear exempt and sound from all claims other
 continuances whatsoever unto the said Joseph Senor his heirs and assigns
 all and every person or persons whatsoever does shall and will by these presents
 forever remnant and defend. In Testimony whereof the said Frances Senor
