his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land or all the right title claim or interest  
the said Allen Edwards and Eliza his wife, has in the tract of land or plantation  
whereon Harry Bullard resided in his life time which land is bounded on the north  
east by the lands of Samuel Bennett by the lands formerly Kelley Dales on the south  
by the lands of Marinda Duke Branch on the West and North, and Robert Drayton's  
on the East, together with all the interest title claim or demand the said Allen Edwards  
and Eliza his wife has in all and singular the houses, barns, buildings, stables, yards,  
gardens, orchards, lands, tenements and lands, pasture for sheep, Common, Wood, meadows,  
ways, waters, water course, fishings, fifties, arboratus, embankments and appurte-  
nances what ever to the said land belonging or appertaining, or with the same used or enjoyed  
or accepted, rehputed, taken, or known as part, part or member thereof, or as belonging to the said  
or any part thereof. To have and to hold the said interest as aforesaid in the said tract of  
land, with the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular as other the premises above mentioned  
intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every  
of their rights, members and appurtenances thereto unto the said James Lenni his heirs
