This Indenture made this 26th day of November in the year of our Lord Christ eight-
een hundred and thirty three Between Benjamin Griffin (Trustee) of the first part, William
Griffin (the debtor) of the second part and Allen Edwards (the creditor) of the third part.
Witness the said William Griffin, on the 11th day of August in the year 1832 in order to
secure the payment of a certain sum of money therein specified to a certain Joseph Soyner for
which the said Allen Edwards stands bound as security, made by Indenture of Trust of that
date convey to the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs &c. the following property Real Tract or
parcel of Land containing 272 acres more or less, and bounded by the lands of John Holmes
Marmaduke Branch, Henry Lowers heirs, Wiley Wollens heirs and the round hill swamp
Upon Trust, for the uses and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned: Whereas the said
William Griffin hath satisfied in part the debt due said Soyner, as far as the value of
