This Indenture made the 2nd day of December, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty three, between Samuel R Gardner and Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, of the one part, and Hardy Crp of the County of Nansemond and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Samuel R Gardner and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and five dollars to them in hand paid, by the said Hardy Crp at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said Samuel R Gardner and Nancy his wife have granted, bargained and sold, aliot, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents do and each of them doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said Hardy Crp his heirs and assigns, a certain tract, piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton, and marked and bounded as follows: Beginning at a pine, a corner of the said Hardy Crp, thence due N 18^o poles to a gum, thence N 5^o E 22 poles to a maple thence N 15^o E 30 poles to a red oak, thence N 5^o W 9 poles to a red oak, thence N 39^o W 35^o to a pine, a corner of said Crp land conveyed to him by Deed of Bargain & Sale from William Forler and wife, thence along said line S W 123 poles to the boundary line of Simon Murfie (formerly Jeremiah Bradshaw) thence along said Murfie line 62^{ft} poles to a white oak; thence S 7^o W 42 poles to a dead burnt gum, a corner in said tract thence S 58^o E 25 poles to a pine stump, thence N 7^o E 98 poles to the beginning, containing fifty six acres and two rods more or less.
