

Secure the said John Demaree and Louis A Branch from any damages which they may sustain or
likely to sustain in consequence of their buying his security. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for
and in consideration of the premises, and also for the further consideration of one dollar, to the said
Henry North in hand paid by the said William D Hood at and before the sealing and delivery of
these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Henry North, hath given, granted,
conveyed, sold, aliened, conveyed, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant,
convey, sell, alien, convey, release and confirm to the said William D Hood his heirs and assigns
forever the following property to-wit: a negro female slave by the name of Rachel, and her child
Henry, two horses, three beds, bedsteads and furniture, one work steer, and three cows, one clock, one
looking glass, three sets of nighting shoes, seven Walnut chairs, one set of knives and forks, three
dishes, and one dozen plates, three iron pots, one doornail and two spinning wheels. To have and
to hold the said granted or intended to be hereby granted personal property and the future increase
of the female slave unto the said William D Hood his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns
forever, to the only proper use and behoof of the said William D Hood his heirs and assigns forever
and the said Henry North for himself, his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns forever doth hereby
covenant, promise and agree to and with the said William D Hood his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns
forever in manner and form following, that is to say, that the said Henry North his heirs, Executors, administrators
and assigns, the aforesaid personal property hereby conveyed unto the said William D Hood his heirs
Executors, administrators and assigns, against all persons whatsoever, shall and well warrant and forever de-
fend by these presents. Upon Trust nevertheless, the said William D Hood his heirs, Executors, administrators
shall permit the said Henry North to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said personal
property hereby conveyed, and take the profits thereof to his own use until default is made in the
payment of the said sum of five hundred and forty three dollars and sixty nine cents, either in the
whole or in part: and then upon further Trust, that he the said William D Hood his heirs or
assigns, so soon after the happening of such default of payment, or the institution of a suit on
the above sum in which the said John Demaree and Louis A Branch their heirs Executors,
administrators or assigns shall request, sell the said personal property and the aforesaid slave or any
part thereof as shall be sufficient for the purpose therein mentioned, to the highest bidder for
ready money at public auction, after having fixed the time and place of sale, at his own discre-
tion, and twenty days notice thereof previous to the day of the sale and out of the money arising
of such sale, shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending the premises
pay to the said John A North the full amount due him with the legal interest accrued on
which the said John Demaree and Louis A Branch are standing bound as security, and
pay the remainder if any to the said Henry North his heirs Executors, administrators, but if the whole of the
above mentioned sum shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said John A North his heirs
Executors, administrators or assigns, so that no default of the said above mentioned sum be made then they
intend to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue. In Witness whereof the said parties
