Witnesseth that the said John Royal of his own free will and consent of the sum of seventy five Dollars to him in hand paid by the said James Rochelle at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Royal has granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed and confirmed unto the said James Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing sixteen and three fourths acres and bounded by the land of Le Sol Waddell, Samuel Mallais and said James Rochelle it being the tract or parcel of land which David Royal purchased of Thomas & Williams as well appears by his subscribing date the day of _____ and of Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court which tract of land the said John Royal became entitled to and possessed of by the death of the said David Royal together with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining To have and to hold the said sixteen and three fourths acres of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular also the premises herebefore mentioned to be bargained and sold unto every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said James Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose use and behoof of him the said James Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever And the said John Royal for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said sixteen and three fourths acres of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said James Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of him the said John Royal his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do now or hereafter forever departed by these presents.
