

1834 Between Yorkles
Jones & Musgrave

This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of January in the
County of Lawrence State of Alabama of the one part and Robert T. Mulligan of South-
ampton State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Jones for and in consideration
of the sum of Six hundred and Thirty Eight dollars to him by the said Robert Musgrave in hand paid
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have granted bargained and sold and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Robert T. Musgrave his heirs
and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land being an undivided moiety of a tract of land lying
long and situated in the County of Southampton formerly belonging to Thomas Marion and bounded
as follows. Commencing at a dead pine between Ellis and Davis and running S. 8. E. 4. 40 Paces
S. 97^o E. 6^o 17' 08" p. S. 12^o E. 17' 08" p. a Red Oak corner between Ellis and Davis S. 68^o E. 10. 93" p.

tree S. 78^o W. 49^o 84' to a pine S. 6. 63^o N. 10. 96' E. 14^o W. 4. 36' to a Maple S. 2^o E. 9. 52' to Deer Branch
thence along said Branch to its junction with Cabin Branch thence along the various courses
of said branch to a pine at the junction with Cox Branch thence along various courses of
said branch to a Branch along said Branch to the beginning containing fair hundred and
sixty four acres. To have and to hold the said land with the appurtenances thereto
belonging to him the said Robert T. Musgrave his heirs and assigns to the only purpose
and intent of the said Robert T. Musgrave his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Yorkles M. Jones for himself his heirs Exec and Assigns doth hereby covenant and agree to
and with the said Robert Musgrave his heirs and assigns that he the said Jones and his the
said land with its appurtenances unto him the said Robert Musgrave his heirs and assigns
against him the said Yorkles and his heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall
and will by these presents forever warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said

J. A. Wickham are held and firmly bound unto Robert T. Musgrave in the sum and sum-
mons of Two hundred dollars to be paid to the said Musgrave his Attorney his heirs
executors and assigns for the payment whereof will and may be made as by
mechanics his exec and assigns jointly and severally firmly by these presents to
be paid with costs and dated this 20th day of January 1834
The condition of the above obligation is such that whenever the above bound
Yorkles by his Due of bargain and sale executed to Robert T. Musgrave this 20th day
of January 1834 have sold and conveyed to the said Musgrave a certain tract of
land being an undivided moiety of tract lying in Southampton mentioned in the
said indenture as is the said express. The above land belongs to said Jones in
