Blunt and Sally his wife do for ourselves our heirs Executors administrators or assigns warrant and forever defend the said tract or parcel of land against the right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons what so ever. With special that for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand one hundred and twenty five dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Howell Harris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Howell Harris his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances thereto.
