Jones' line thence along said Jones' line to a pine a corner in said line, thence along said line to a red or black oak a corner in said William A. Jones' line thence to Solomon A. Thomas' line thence along said Thomas' line to a scrubby oak thence to George Jory's line thence along said Jory's line to a Gum in the flat Swamp thence down the ancient courses of the said flat Swamp to the beginning. To have and to hold the said foregoing tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Benjamin E. Blunt and Sally his wife, to the only and proper use of the said Anne Harris her heirs and assigns forever and we the said Benjamin E. Blunt and Sally his wife do for ourselves our heirs Executors Administrators and assigns warrant and forever defend the said tract or parcel of Land unto the right full claim or interest of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
