Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Devany, Edwards Bute, Clemente Rochelle, Thomas Ridley, Lewis Wonell, William Nicholson, and William Briggs, are held and firmly bound unto John Floyd Esq. Governor or chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of thirty ~~thousand~~ ^{thousand} dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his heirs or assigns for the use of the Commonwealth, for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves, and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our Seals and dated this 20th day of January 1834
The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Benjamin Devany is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth, dated the 13th day of December 1833. to Continue in Office until the first quarterly Term of the Court of the said County for the year 1835. If therefore the said Benjamin Devany shall well and truly collect and receive all officers fees and dues put into his hands to collect, and duly account for and pay the same to the Officers to whom such fees are due respectively, at such Times as are prescribed and limited by Law, and shall well and truly execute and due return make of all process and precepts to him directed and pay and satisfy all sums of money and to those by him received, by return of any such process to the persons to whom the same are due his or their executors, administrators or assigns and in all things truly and faithfully execute and perform the said Office of Sheriff during the term of his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
