This Indenture made this 28. day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand  
Eight hundred and thirty three. Between Joshua W. Myrick of the first part, Solomon  
D. Parker of the second part and George A. W. Newson of the third part. Whereof  
the said Joshua W. Myrick is justly indebted to the said George A. W. Newson  
in the sum of One hundred and thirty six dollars and thirty two Cents the said  
on the 25. day of December 1833. as by a Bond bearing date the 28. day of December  
1833 more fully appears which debt with lawful interest thereon the said Joshua  
W. Myrick is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture Witnesseth  
that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration  
of one dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said Joshua W. Myrick in hand  
paid by the said Solomon D. Parker at one before the sealing and delivery of these  
premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Joshua W. Myrick  
each of us granted bargain sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released and confirmed and  
by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm  
to the said Solomon D. Parker his heirs and assigns forever, all the interest he  
has, may or can have, in the uninclosed tract or parcel of land of which Joshua  
Myrick late of the County of Southampton died seized and possessed by right and  
being in the County of Southampton on the North side of the Three Cayles and bounded  
by the lands of E. Pettway's estate James E. Peters and Josef Fort's Estate containing  
by estimation one thousand acres be the same more or less with all and singular  
the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any way  
pertaining, and all the estate right title and interest of the said Joshua W. Myrick  
in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of land  
and premises. To have and to hold the said hereby granted tract or parcel of land
