 has, may or may have, in the undivided tract or parcel of land of which Joshua
 Myrick late of the County of Southampton died seized and possessed lying and
 being in the County of Southampton on the stretch side of the Three Cigarettes and divided
 by the lands of E. Pettway's estate James E. Peters and Joseph Fort's Estate containing
 by estimation one thousand acres be the same more or less with all and singular
 the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any way
 pertaining, and all the estate right title and interest of the said Joshua W. Myrick
 in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of land
 and premises. To have and to hold the said hereby granted intended to be
