On this Indenture witnesseth that the said Barton Chitty in Consideration of the premises aforesaid in the further Consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain grant and sell unto the said James C Taylor his heirs and assigns the following property to wit one Sonne mare which was purchased of the said James C Taylor three years of Cattle two Sons and pigs. To have and to hold to him the said James Taylor his heirs or assigns forever and the said Barton Chitty doth for his heirs and assigns do warrant and defend the title of above mentioned property against the lawful claim of all persons whatsoever claiming the same or any part thereof unto the said James Taylor his heirs or assigns forever upon Special Trust and Condition nevertheless that the said Thomas Porter may at any time after the 11<sup>th</sup> day of September by request of either of the parties sell for ready money all the property herein contained first advertising the day and place of such ten days previously or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to discharge the aforesaid debt interest and cost including his Conveying into effect these presents witnesseth whereof the aforesaid parties have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first written.
