and in Consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and thirty nine dollars and eighty
cents to them on hand paid by the said Elijah Adams at or before the making and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
bargained sold aliened released and confirmed unto the said Elijah Adams and his
heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land being part of the tract
known as the Execution of Robert Ricks lying and lying in the County of South-
ampton and Containing four hundred and ninety one and a tenth acre and bounded
as follows beginning at a post oak a post made corner tree on the side of the main
