This Indenture made this 6 day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between Emily P. Williamson of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part, and John P. Emathay of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty four dollars to her in hand paid, or deemed to be paid before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged like the said Emily P. Williamson hath bought and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John P. Emathay his heirs and assigns all his right title and interest that she now owns or was any time from any cause whatever in all the land which Miller Williamson her father late of Southampton died seized and possessed of, bounded by the lands of John Williamson Joel Carpenter others. To have and to hold the said Land with the Tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances unto the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bought and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with warranty their right heirs and assigns unto the said John P. Emathay his heirs and assigns forever, unto the said Emily P. Williamson and her heirs the said Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John P. Emathay his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of her the said Emily P. Williamson and her heirs and of all and every person or persons whomsoever shall arise and by these presents, warrant and forever defend the said title and interest unto the said John P.
