

This Indenture made this 22nd day of February in the year of our Lord 1834 between
 the said *Anthony M. Howell* and *Emmy Howell* his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part
 and *Dempsey Pleythe* of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said *Anthony M. Howell*
 and *Emmy Howell* his wife do hereby acknowledge and therefore acquit and discharge the
 said *Dempsey Pleythe* his heirs and assigns forever and themselves to be fully and entirely
 satisfied contented and paid have granted bargained sold aliened and offloaded and conveyed
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and offload release let our delay confirm
 unto him the said *Dempsey Pleythe* and to his heirs assigns forever all that plantation
 being part and parcel of land wherein the said *Dempsey Pleythe* now lives and lying
 tract of ground of *Anthony M. Howell* situated lying and being in the County of Southampton
 aforesaid and containing by estimation twenty five acres the same more or
 less bounded as follows To wit beginning at a certain tree a corner post made thereunto
 by a large corner tree marked tree of the said lands and in the Branch which is a hedge
 thence up the Branch to a street corner thence a line of marked trees to a pine corner
 thence along said line to a line of marked trees to a corner post of *Bartholomew*
 thence along said line to a line of marked trees thence corner of said land
 to a pine corner of said land and thence a straight line to the beginning With all
 appurtenances what ever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the
 same and reversions Remainder and Commandments here upon and of the same and all the
 estate right title and interest claims or demands of them the said *Anthony M. Howell*
 of or and to the said and every part thereof To have and to hold the said plantation
 tract or parcel of land and premises aforesaid unto him the said *Dempsey Pleythe* his heirs
 and assigns forever and the said *Anthony M. Howell* and *Emmy Howell* his wife for themselves
 their heirs Executors and administrators or assigns the said twenty five acres of land and
 premises with all and every the appurtenances aforesaid against him the said *Anthony*
M. Howell and his heirs and against all persons what ever claims or demands the
 said or any part shall and well warrant and for ever defend by these presents
