 To Smithampton of the first part T. R. Gray of the second part, and Mills E. Lawrence of the
 Lawrence third part, Witnesseth that the said Matthew Williams for and in consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said T. R. Gray at or before the executing and delivery
 of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged with given granted, bargain and
 sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Gray his heirs
 Executors and assigns the following property to wit One negro girl about fourteen years of age named
 Abbie and one negro fellow named Isaac and one yoke of Oxen To have and to hold
 the aforesaid granted property against the claim of him the said Matthew Williams
 or all and every person or persons whatsoever upon Trust nevertheless that whereas the said Matthew
 Williams is indebted to the said Mills E. Lawrence in the sum of Two hundred and thirty
 dollars by Bond bearing date the 29th of October 1833, and being desirous to secure the
 same in this Indenture Witnesseth that if the said Matthew Williams shall be
 default in the payment of the said Debt to the said Lawrence when he shall be
 hereafter required then and on such default being made the said Gray shall when
 he is required by the said Lawrence after giving lawful notice of the time and place
 of sale proceed to sell the aforesaid Shares and Oxen according to Law and after full payment
 of the said Debt, interest and costs of this Indenture pay over the balance to the said
 Mills E. Lawrence his Executors or Administrators. In Witness whereof the parties have hereunto
