Deed of Sale. This Indenture made this thirtieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between Jason M. DeLk Commissioner appointed by the County Court of Surhampton County to carry into effect a decree pronounced at January Term 1833 directing the Sale of the one fourth part of the Upper Mill wharf of Adams DeLk said seized and possessed of the one part and Joseph Prillor of the County of Surry of the other part. Witnessed that the said Jason M. DeLk Commissioner as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Jason M. DeLk hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Prillor his heirs and assigns the undivided one fourth part of the Upper Mill in the County of Surhampton, wherof Adams DeLk said seized and possessed, together with the lots of land attached to the said Mill, and also all woods unenclosed, ways, waters and Comers profits, Commodities, advantages, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever belonging to the said Mill and lots of land and the Reversion and Reversions Comers and profits of the said Mill and lots of land and every part and parcel thereof and the right title and interest claim and demand whatever. To have and to hold the said lots of land above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph Prillor his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Joseph Prillor his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof the said Jason M. DeLk Commissioner as aforesaid and in virtue of the aforesaid decree, hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and date first above written.
