this which was advertised and sold as is herein directed and the same was purchased by the aforesaid
said Robert Peller for the aforesaid sum of Two hundred and ten dollars To have and to hold
the same unto the said Robert Peller his heirs and assigns to him and his use and behoof
forever And I the said Joseph Peller do covenant with the said Robert Peller his heirs and
assigns that I will warrant and defend the same to the said Robert Peller against the
lawful claims and demands of the said Edward C. Bailey or any other person or persons claiming
