This Indenture made this 9th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between Allen Edwards and Eliot his wife of the one part and Gordon Bradshaw of the other part Witnesseth that the said Allen Edwards and Eliot his wife in consideration of one hundred and eighty seven dollars fifty Cents of lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Gordon Bradshaw to wit the receipt and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Gordon Bradshaw for himself and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Southampton formerly the property of Henry Lawrence and lying on the East Side of the main road leading from Benjamin Christies to Boytons Mill and bounded by the lands of Allen Edwards, Joseph James Clayton and the lands of Philip Rufford dec^d containing one hundred and six acres more or less together with all houses and appurtenances thereto belonging To have and to hold the said land and premises to him and his heirs forever and the said Allen Edwards and Eliot his wife for themselves themselves do each by these presents covenant and grant it and with the said Gordon Bradshaw that they the said Allen Edwards and Eliot his wife against all persons claiming by or through them the after said tract of land with firm warrant and defend. In Witness whereof the said Allen Edwards and Eliot his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year above written.
