Pote his heirs & assigns a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and being the proportion allotted to said Fitzhugh in the division of his father's Thomas Fitzhugh's land all of which will more fully appear by reference to the report of Commissioners who divided the same together with all and singular its appurtenances To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of land together with all and singular its appurtenances after said unto the said Mark T. Pote his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Mark T. This Indenture made and entered into on the twenty fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty four between James Repton of the first part and Mary Maget Struts of the second part, and Lewis Morrell of the third part all of the County of Chester and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said James Repton stands partly indebted unto the said Lewis Morrell by note bearing date even these presents for the sum of Five hundred and thirteen dollars and the said James Repton being willing and desirous to discharge the principal thereof with the interest that may accrue thereon hath for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Mary Maget Struts at or before the making hereof of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns forever and assigns forever the following property to wit one negro man named Jack, one black mare one brandy still, still room &c. and all the future crop of the said brandy still for the present year together with all right title interest claim or demand of or to the said negro man Jack, do not have one black mare one brandy still still room &c. and crop for the present year &c. To have and to hold the same unto him the said Lewis Maget Struts his heirs, Executors and assigns forever
