Between James Bryant of the first part and Major Trustee of the second part and Lewis Morrell of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Metropole that whereas the said James Bryant stands forth into the said Lewis Morrell by note bearing date with these presents for the sum of One hundred and thirteen dollars and the said James Bryant being willing and desirous to sum the payment thereof with the interest that may accrue thereon hath for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Major Major Trustee at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Major Major Trustee administration and assigns forever the following property to wit one negro man named Jack and his wife one black mare one brandy still still worm V.C. and all the future crop of the said brandy still for the present year together with all right title interest claim or demand for and to the said negro man and his wife one black mare one brandy still still worm V.C. and crop for the present year and to have and to hold the same unto him the said Major Major Trustee his heirs Executors and administrators
