Containing One hundred acres be the same more or less also one tract or parcel of land lying and
in the County and State aforesaid lately purchased by the said Sykes of the said Joseph T. Cloud
More or less containing three hundred and thirty acres be the same more or less also one tract or
parcel of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid being a part of the tract
of land lately purchased of Robert Tellergraves by the said John Sykes containing two
and twenty acres be the same more or less and also the following negroes to wit thirty
Kinck, Dennis, Ned, Phelip, Weller, Jean and Isabel together with four horned
cattle, sixteen sheep, forty five hogs, one gig, one pair Cart wheels and all the farming utensils
each and sundries and all the household and kitchen furniture of said Sykes and
his interest in, to, or out of the aforesaid property. To have and to hold to the said Robert
Tellergraves his heirs and assigns upon Trust nevertheless that the said Robert Tellergraves
whenever payment of either or any of the above bonds shall be required or so soon as required
by the said Joseph T. Cloud proceed to sell the property before mentioned to the highest bidder
for cash or so much thereof as will be sufficient to satisfy the debt which may at that
time be payable, after first giving One months public notice of the time and place
and out of the monies arising from such sales, after first deducting the Costs and charges
attending the sales and the execution of this trust pay off the several bonds before
together with such other bonds as the said Joseph T. Cloud may on the return
paid for the said John Sykes and the balance if any pay into the hands of the said
