This Indenture made and entered into this first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
thirty three Between Thomas Hart of Southampton County of the first part Iyo Hart of said County of the second part  
and George Gay of said County of the third part and all in the State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Thomas  
Hart and Iyo Hart doth credit to the said Iyo Hart in the sum of One hundred & twenty dollars which were fully agreed  
by his bond executed to the said Iyo Hart for the above mentioned sum with growing interest and for the sum  
of One dollar to have the said Thomas Hart in hands paid by the said George Gay at or before  
the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1834 for the delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and granted by the said George  
Gay in this and aforesaid a certain piece or parcel of land and part of the tract on which I now dwell situate  
to be forty acres bounded as follows adjoining the land of Iyo Hart and <sup>the West</sup> lying thereby on the South  
Bank of Andrew on the West and the land of said Iyo Hart unto the said George Gay his heirs and  
assigns forever in trust nevertheless the said Iyo Hart his heirs and assigns shall have it in their power  
to sell or the said George Gay his heirs Execution or admiring Tutors at any time to execute and sell the said  
land after giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale for ready money and out of the money arising  
from such sale first pay and discharge all reasonable expenses attending the sale the drawing and  
recording of this Indenture then the debt herein mentioned with the interest and the sum of any  
to pay and return to the said Thomas Hart or his legal representatives In witness whereof  
the parties present have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written  
Signed sealed and acknowledged  
in the presence of Test.

Bondsell This Indenture made and entered into this the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year 1834 Between Iyo  
Bondsell Sheriff of the County of Southampton of the one part and Davis Banet of the other part witnesseth  
that the said Davis Banet Bondsell Sheriff as aforesaid in pursuance of a Order of the Circuit Court in  
Court of Law and Chancery for James City County and City of Williamsburg pronounced on the 28<sup>th</sup> day  
of October 1833 on a Suit in Chancery wherein defendant between James Rochester and with the  
well known of John Thomas et al. plaintiff against John C. Gurley son of George Gurley deceased  
and on his own right and others defendants and of a Sale made by him in virtue of the said several  
public Auction of the tract of land therein mentioned at which Sale the said Davis Banet Bondsell  
purchased at the price of Fifteen hundred and five dollars and in consideration of the sum of  
Fifteen hundred and five dollars to him due and to be paid by the said Davis Banet before the  
delivery and delivery of these presents hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth  
grant bargain and sell also in exchange and confirm unto the said Davis Banet his heirs  
and assigns the said tract of land above mentioned lying in Southampton County estimated to contain  
four hundred and Eighty three acres of which George Gurley did die and proposed to sell  
such all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold the said tract  
parcel of land with the appurtenances to the said Davis Banet his heirs and assigns to the only  
person and behalf of him the said Davis Banet his heirs and assigns forever And the said  
Davis Banet Sheriff as aforesaid for himself his heirs Executors and administrators hereby do warrant and
