and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars to the said Goodman E.
and Martha his wife in hand paid by the said Lawrence Gardner at and before the making
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Goodman E.
son and Martha his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give away
and sell unto the said Lawrence Gardner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and marked and bounded as follows
beginning at a sloping pine a corner of the land of John T. Cope Esq^r and thence to a black
willow pole to a dead pine then 112. 10. 42 poles to a dead pine a corner standing near a hollow
tall corner and thence 378. 6. 22 poles to a red oak near another corner of said Cope's land
then East 36. 4 poles to a small pine a common said Goodman C. Johnson's on land thence
on said Johnson's 35. 6. 14. 4 poles to a stake in the boundary line of the land belonging to
the heirs of John T. Cope Esq^r thence along said line 83. 11. 48 poles to the beginning containing
fifty acres together with all and singular the revenues and issues therefrom
and remainders yearly and other rents espes and profits thereof and every part and parcel
