Beginning at the mouth of the long Branch where it runs in the Creek thence up the Creek to Lawrence's line or on Ballards Mill thence up the Little long Branch a line of marked trees adjoining the said Henry Lawrence to a pine cone between the said Pine Henry Lawrence and John Ragsland thence a line of marked trees to the long Branch thence down the long Branch to the beginning together with all the singular houses and houses lands and doing Stables yards gardens orchards lands tenements meadows pastures feeding Commons woods ways streets and water courses fishing pits daps profits and easements Commodities advantages emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances what so ever to the said Zachariah Lankford and Martha his wife belonging or appertaining or with the same used or enjoyed or accepted reputed taken or known as a part parcel or member thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof and the recesses and recessions Remainder and Remainders specially and otherwise then and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the tract of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular thereto premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Joshua Whitney his heirs and assigns forever. And for the only purpose and behoof of him the said Joshua Whitney his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Zachariah Lankford and Martha his wife for themselves and their heirs the said forty acres of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Joshua Whitney his heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims of them the said Zachariah Lankford and Martha his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs of all and every person or persons what so ever shall ever and do servant and serve in defense by these presents.
