This Indenture made the 9 day of December in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty three between John P. Pleasants and Lucy his wife of the County of Surry of the one part and Benjamin L. Drew of the County of Northampton of the other part all of the State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said John P. Pleasants and Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid or otherwise deemed to be paid by the said Benjamin L. Drew at before the ensueing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John P. Pleasants and Lucy his wife doth hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and by these presents doth sell of their dish bargains and sell unto the said Benjamin L. Drew his heirs and assigns all that tract and parcel of land lying and being in the County of Northampton and bounded in the following manner Viz On the East by the great branch of the South by the lands of the said Benjamin L. Drew purchase of Hamilton Tani (Senr) and the lands of Benjamin Smith and the West by Charles Hunt and on the North by the lands whereon the said Benjamin L. Pleasants resides and the lands of Martine Hunt id being all the lands the said John P. Pleasants and his wife claim title to in the County of Northampton and containing by estimation one hundred and twenty one acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging and the revenues and revenues thereon as and remaind as aforesaid and also rents fees and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of them rights members and appurtenances unto the said Benjamin L. Drew his heirs and assigns forever the said John P. Pleasants and Lucy his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Benjamin L. Drew his heirs and assigns free from the claim of them the said John P. Pleasants and Lucy his wife their heirs or assigns and of all and every person or persons whomsoever that and do claimant and former debts by these presents. In Witness whereof the said John P.
