Williams to secure the said debt. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Matthias Williams for and in consideration of the premises and for the sum of one hundred and one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth bargain and sell unto the said William Owens his heirs and assigns all the plantation tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of Edwin T. Hart. William Owens and others containing by estimation three hundred and thirty seven and a half acres be the same more or less, and all the rights and title of the said Matthias Williams in and to the same To have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with every of the appurtenances unto him the said William Owens his heirs and assigns in trust forever and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that of the said Matthias Williams shall punctually pay unto the said James M. Williams his heirs or assigns the said Sum of five hundred and twenty five dollars and
