This Indenture made and entered into this the 18 day of March 1834 between Samuel Calvert
 of the first part and Thomas C. Jones of the other part. Whereas Jacob Pope deceased in his
 will made and provided for the payment of a debt due from him to William E. Daughtry as his security to a fourth coming bond due on the 17. day of February 1833
 by an Indenture of that date. Emory to the said Samuel Calvert a certain tract of land
 in Southampton County containing fifty acres more or less in trust nevertheless and with power
 and authority to the said Samuel Calvert to sell the same for the purpose of paying the debt
 the said William E. Daughtry owed and the debt due which the said William E. Daughtry
 was security and the expenses attending the execution of the said trust in and about the said
 said Pope should feel to discharge the same. And whereas the said Jacob Pope having failed
 to discharge the debt aforesaid the said Samuel Calvert in execution of the trust (after giving
 him public notice thereof) did on the 18. day of March 1834 expose to sale at public auction the
 highest bidder for ready money the said tract of land and at the sale he made the said Thomas
 Jones become the purchaser of the aforesaid tract of land by bidding therefor the sum of Eighty one dollars
 which was the highest bid made for the same and that sum he has since paid to the said Samuel
 Calvert. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Samuel Calvert for and in satisfaction
 of the said sum of Eighty one dollars paid to him by the said Thomas C. Jones as above stated
 hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell
 unto the said Thomas C. Jones his heirs and assigns the same tract of land heretofore
 together with the buildings and improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging
 have and to hold the said tract of land and the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Thomas
 Estate, right, title, and interest of the said Samuel Calvert therein unto the said Thomas C.
 Jones his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof forever. And the said
 Samuel Calvert for himself his heirs executors and administrators hereby Covenant to and warrant to the
 said Thomas C. Jones his heirs and assigns that he well perform warrant and defend the
 said tract of land hereby conveyed with the buildings and improvements thereon and the ap-
 purtenances thereto belonging to the said Thomas C. Jones his heirs and assigns against the
 of the said Samuel Calvert and all persons claiming the same or any part thereof
 through or under him the said Samuel Calvert but against the claim or claim of any
 person or persons whomsoever. In Witness whereof the said Samuel Calvert hath here-
 set his hand and affixed his seal this the day and year first before written
 signed sealed and delivered
