This Indenture made and entered into this 11 day of January in the year of our Lord One thou-
sand Eight hundred and thirty four. Between Levi Waller of the first part and Aunt Harris of the
second part and Peter Edwards who is mutually known as Trustee of the third part, all of the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that whereas the said Levi Waller is duly
indebted to the said Aunt Harris in the Sum of One thousand and seventy one dollar and 27
Cents for which sum the said Waller has executed his bond to the said Harris bearing date with
these presents. And the said Levi Waller being desirous to secure the payment of the said bond
to the said Harris and further in consideration of the sum of One dollar in hand paid the said
Levi Waller by the said Peter Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said
Waller hereby granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto
the said Peter Edwards the following property to wit. One tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the County and State aforesaid being the land on which said Levi Waller now resides contain-
ing two hundred acres more or less, with all the privileges, improvements, and appurtenances
thereto belonging and these premises named as follows Town, Mills and Miles and all his interest
in to out of the said property. To have and to hold to the said Peter Edwards his heirs and
assigns forever and against former and future trust nevertheless that the said Peter Edwards shall as soon as
notified by the said Aunt Harris his agent or assigns proceed to sell the property before
mentioned to the highest bidder for cash. After giving fifteen days public notice of the time
and place of such sale, and out of the money arising therefrom pay off the amount of the debt
before mentioned and interest and the Cost attending this conveyance and the Sale of the property
