Griffin of the second part and Rebecca Whitfield of the third part each and all of the parties of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said Shattley Bryant doth stand indebted to the said Rebecca Whitfield in the first sum of forty dollars bearing date with these presents due by note And he the said Shattley Bryant being satisfied and bound to the said Rebecca Whitfield the above amount doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Jonathan T. Griffin the following property to wit: A certain lot and sum of one acre and two pines trees four sitting chairs one bed spread two Caneing axes Set of Carthage Wheel Case of knives and forks one Coffee pot three razors one broad iron also all of my part of my present growing Crop Consisting of Cotton seeds &c. to him the said J. T. Griffin. To have and to hold to him and his heirs forever on special trust and confidence and the said Bryant doth by these presents warrant and veil for him defend all right title interest and claims in and to the above unto him the said Jonathan T. Griffin and his heirs forever notwithstanding this hereby granted and entered that the request of either of the parties be the said J. T. Griffin proceeds to advertise the said before named property and makes Sale of it on the day of for cash and after having paid off the said debt and interest unto the said J. T. Griffin the said J. T. Griffin shall pay unto him the said Shattley Bryant or his representative or order all surplus money arising from the said Sale of any.
