This Indenture made this Second day of July One thousand Eight hundred and thirty four
Between Jesse S. Barham of the one part and Drury Waller of the other part all of the County of
Savannah and State of Georgia Witnesses that the said Jesse S. Barham doth for and in
consideration of the sum of six hundred and three dollars to him in hand paid by the said Drury
Waller at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledgeed hath granted bargain and sold aliened and Conferred unto him the said Drury
Waller his heirs and assigns forever One Certain parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in
the aforesaid County and bounded as follows. Beginning at a forked red oak a corner of Chapman's land
more Thomas North Seventy degrees East forty poles thence S 70. N. East Sixty poles thence S 87. D.
East twenty poles to a large gum in the said line thence S 55. D. East forty five poles to a hickory
a corner of William Foster's land thence S 87. Degrees N. ninety six poles to a black pole a corner of land
John's land thence S 7. D. East One hundred and sixteen poles to a black gum in the said line
of the Buckhorn Swamp thence up the stream of said Swamp two hundred and fifteen
poles to dead oak a corner of said Foster, William and Thomas thence S 16. N. West seventy poles
to a maple in Thomas's line thence S 8. D. West ninety Eight poles to a post in Drury Waller's
line thence along the said Waller's line to the beginning. Containing two hundred and forty and
be the same more or less. To have and to hold the said two hundred and forty acres of land with
all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Drury Waller his heirs and
his assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Drury Waller his heirs and assigns
and the said Jesse S. Barham doth Covenant and agree with the said Drury Waller his
heirs and assigns shall forever defend the title of the aforesaid land unto him
the said Drury Waller his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims or claims of any

and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sold unto the said William E.
Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever all and singular rights title and interest that we now have
