This Indenture made and entered into this the day of December in the year 1833 between Thomas C. Jones of the first part Luitell R. Edwards of the second part and Edwards Betts, Clements Rochelle, Jeremiah Cobb, William A. Spack and others of the third part. Whereas the said Thomas C. Jones together with the said Edwards Betts Clements Rochelle, Jeremiah Cobb, William A. Spack and others his servants did on the day of December 1833 execute three several Notes or Specialties to Henry B. Cloughan for the sum of One thousand dollars each, with interest from the 25. day of December 1833. One of the said Notes or Specialties on demand the 25. day of December 1834 another on demand the 25. day of December 1835. and the third on demand the 25. day of December 1836. and the said Thomas C. Jones being willing and desirous to indemnify and save the aforesaid Cloughan from sustaining any loss or damage whatever by reason of their Suretyship aforesaid and in consideration of the premises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Luitell R.
