 the premises and for the consideration of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by the said J. C. Mason  
 and a before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and I  
 have granted bargained sold aliened assigned and delivered over to the said J. C. Mason all the  
 right title interest claim and demand in and to the aforesaid granted premises which I should  
 have the said A. P. Fiske as Tenet. To have and to hold the aforesaid granted premises  
 to him the said J. C. Mason his heirs and assigns forever against the claims of whom the said  
 J. C. Mason Justice or all and every person or persons claiming by or through him as Heir or my  
 hand and Seal this 12. of July 1834.

The words by the said J. C. Mason intimated before signing. J. C. Mason Justice (Seal)

 This indenture was acknowledged by Thomas R. Gray party thereto and admitted to  
 record and at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 21. day of July 1834. The said  
 indenture was entered upon the proceedings of the day  
 Witness James Rochelle C.

This indenture made and entered into this 25. day of December in the year 1833  
 between Thomas R. Jones of the first part Squire R. Edwards of the second part and  
 Edwards Pettis, Clements Rochelle, Jeremiah Cobb, William A. Spack and others of the third  
 part. Whereas the said Thomas R. Jones together with the said Edwards Pettis Clements  
 Rochelle, Jeremiah Cobb, William A. Spack and others his Squire did on the day of Dec-  
 ember 1833 execute three several Notes or Specialties to Henry B. Cloughan for the sum  
 of One thousand dollars each, each interest from the 25. day of December 1833. One of the  
 said Notes or Specialties on demand the 25. day of December 1834 another on demand the 25  
 day of December 1835. and the third on demand the 25. day of December 1836. and the said  
 Thomas R. Jones being willing and desirous to indemnify and save the aforesaid Secured from  
 sustaining any loss or damage whatsoever by reason of their Suretyship aforesaid and in  
 consideration of the premises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar  
 to him in hand paid by the said Squire R. Edwards and before the sealing and delivery of these  
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has given granted bargained and sold  
 and does by these presents give grant bargain and sell unto the said Squire R. Edwards his  
 heirs Executors administrators or assigns the following property to wit a Certain lot or piece of  
 land situate in and adjacent to the town of Jerusalem, Containing by Survey Seven and two  
 thirds acres, being the lot or piece of land purchased by the said Jones of Henry B. Cloughan  
 by deed bearing date the 17. day of December 1833. reference being had to that deed the  
 descriptions of the said land well appears together with all the buildings and improvements  
 on the said lot or piece of land and the appurtenances thereof of any description also the  
 house hold and kitchen furniture of any description attached to, appertaining, or belonging to  
 the said Jones on the town of Jerusalem aforesaid and all in the  
 said Jones' household and kitchen furniture of any kind or description whatsoever also  
 horses one Carriage and harness, one single gig, and his Stock of Cattle and hogs and things
