Tagwell Esq^r Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the first and full term of Two thousand dollars to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Governor for the time being and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 21st day of July 1834 The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound John R. Williams had been duly appointed by the County Court of Southampton to serve as Constable in the lower district of Saint Lukes Parish in the County of Southampton until June Court 1835. & for if the said John R. Williams shall well and truly discharge the duties of the said Office of Constable in the said County during his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void & else to remain in full force and entire
