the 21st day of July 1834. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas
the above bound John R. Williams has been duly appointed by the County Court of Southamp-
ton to serve as Constable in the lower district of Saint Luke's Parish in the County of
Southampton until June First 1835. And if the said John R. Williams shall well and
truly discharge the duties of the said Office of Constable in the said County during his
continuance therein then the above obligation to be void as also to remain in full force and witness
