 his mother and Thomas Langham of the other part both of the County of
 Hampshire and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Simon Murfey Com^r
 did this day agree to sell at auction the aforesaid land pursuant to decree and
 the said Thomas Langham became the purchaser for the sum of ten dollars
 more or less Credit And the said Simon Murfey Com^r does for himself and
 heirs heirs and assigns the aforesaid unincorporated part of the tract of
 land in the Bill mentioned to which *Simon Murfey* dec^d was entitled shall
 go to the life estate of Elizabeth Edwards his mother as Commissioner and
 The receipt for the above amount in bonds due some months hence is hereby acknowl-

This Indenture made and entered into on this 6th day of November in the year
 Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Thirty three Between William E. Lawrence
 of the first part William W. Cutler the trustee of the Decedent and John Margrave of
 the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said
 William E. Lawrence stands justly indebted to the said John Margrave by bond
 even date with these presents in the sum of forty dollars and forty four Cents which
 debt with legal interest having accrued the said William E. Lawrence
 doth hereby sell and deliver the same. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that
 and in consideration of the sum of One dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said
 William E. Lawrence in hand paid by the said William W. Cutler the trustee at and by
 the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 by the said William E. Lawrence have given granted bargained sold, aliened conveyed
 released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sold alien convey
 release and confirm to the said William W. Cutler his heirs and assigns forever
 following personal property to wit One horse by the name of *Maresha* One negro man
 slaving One feather bed and furniture Eight of Sheep One blue Cow three Sheds
 But all my Crop of Corn now standing in the field supposed ten Barrels
 of Hides and other things all the right title and interest of the said William
 E. Lawrence in and to the above mentioned property hereby granted or intended to be
 granted personal property as above mentioned unto the said William W. Cutler the
 his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and the William E. Lawrence
 himself his heirs Executors and administrators doth hereby Acknowledge
