This Indenture made this Sixth day of August in the year of our Lord Eight hundred and thirty four. Between Henry B. Naughton of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part and Henry Morrell of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the Said Henry B. Naughton for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand and Eight dollars Current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the Said Henry Morrell at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. hath given bargained sold, aliened enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents doth give bargain sell, alien enfeoff and Confirm unto her the Said Henry Morrell her heirs and assigns forever. One Certain tract or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's Containing by late Survey five hundred and two acres &c the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Black gum Standing in the run of the Swamp a corner for the Division being in said Henry B. Naughton's line, thence along said Survey line of marked trees S 79° W 7 poles to the Center of Barron's road a corner for said line in Amos Stephenson's line, thence along the road said Stephenson's line S 81° W 7 poles thence S 75° W 28 poles thence S 87° W 40 poles thence S 78° W 33 poles thence S 81° W 23 poles thence S 79° W 68 poles thence S 87° W 46 poles thence S 71° W 23 poles to a pine & corner for Jacob Williams thence down the road S 71° W 17 poles thence S 79° W 26 poles thence S 66° W 112 poles thence S 76° W 26 poles thence S 87° W 57 poles thence S 83° W 32 poles thence S 87° W 46 poles thence S 73° W 108 poles thence S 87° W 26 poles to a red oak a corner for Simpson Pope and Joseph Rice thence along said Rice's line of marked trees S 47° E 80 poles to a pine standing near a small branch thence S 44° E 43 poles to a red oak thence S 44° E 52 poles to a red oak thence S 42° E 22 poles thence S 44° E 46 poles to the run of the aforesaid Swamp at a black gum a corner for said Henry B. Naughton in John Thorp's line thence down the line of the run of said Swamp to the beginning. In witness whereof all the right title interest and demand of us and to the Said tract or parcel of land and premises next to appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances unto the Said Henry Morrell her heirs and assigns forever and for the only proper use and behoof of her the Said Henry Morrell her heirs and assigns forever And the Said Henry B. Naughton, for himself his heirs and assigns doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Henry Morrell her heirs heirs assigns and assigns that he will by these presents Covenant and promise defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises, and every part and parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons to whomsoever.
