This Indenture made this Sixth day of August in the year of our Lord Eighty
hundred and thirty four. Between Henry B. Blaugham of the County of Southampton
State of Virginia of the one part and Elamy Morrell of the same County and State
of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry B. Blaugham for and in consideration
of the sum of two thousand and Eight dollars Currant money of the Province
wonth to him in hand paid by the said Elamy Morrell at or before the making
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth make
bargain sold, alured enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell, alure enfeoff and confirm unto her the said Elamy Morrell his heirs
and assigns forever. One certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
aforenamed County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's Containing by late Survey
four hundred and ten acres the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit

appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold
the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular
appurtenances unto the said Elamy Morrell his heirs and assigns forever
for the only proper use and behoof of her the said Elamy Morrell his heirs and
assigns forever. And the said Henry B. Blaugham for himself his executors
doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Elamy Morrell
his heirs executors and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and
secure defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and
premises, and every part and parcel thereof against the claims or demands of
any person or persons whoe ever. In witness whereof the said Henry
