This Indenture made this seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight
hundred and thirty four. Between Nancy Morrell of the County of Southampton of the one part
and Jacob Williams of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Nancy
Morrell for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars current
money of Virginia to her by the said Jacob Williams in hand paid the receipt whereof
the said Nancy Morrell doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold and
conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey to the said Jacob Williams
his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land containing fifty acres be the same
more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit
beginning at a red Oak standing on the North side of Barron's road, a corner for
Joseph Reese and Sampson Pope thence Joseph Reese's line to a fence standing in a
small branch a new corner made between Nancy Morrell and Jacob Williams
thence from the corner pine in Joseph Reese's line S 80° E 150 poles to Simon tree
standing on Barron's road thence up the said road to the beginning containing fifty
acres be the same more or less to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Jacob Williams his heirs
or assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Jacob Williams his heirs or
assigns forever and the said Nancy Morrell for herself her heirs Executors and
doth hereby warrant and agree to and defend the said Jacob Williams his heirs and
assigns that the said Nancy Morrell and her heirs the said tract or parcel of land with
the appurtenances thereto belong to him the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns against the
said Nancy Morrell and her heirs and against all persons whomsoever. Shall and will
